Materion yn codi o'r cofnodion/Matters arising from minutes

- Dal ddim ymateb oddi wrth Mr Cliff Bates o'r Cyngor Sir ynglŷn â'r polyn fflag i'w ddodi ym mharc Llangeitho.
- *Still no response from Mr Cliff James from the County Council about the flagpole to be placed in Llangeitho's park.*
- Julie Osmond, CADW wedi cysylltu ynglŷn â mwy o fanylion am ba mortar sy'n mynd i gael ei ddefnyddio i adnewyddu trwyn y milwr ar y cylchfan.
- *Julie Osmond, CADW, has been in touch with regard to more details about which mortar is going to be used when repairing the nose on the soldier monument.*
- Gan na dderbynnir ymateb dderbyniol i gostau'r etholiadau, gofynnir i Cyng Rhodri Evans gysylltu â Ms Lowri Edwards, Swyddog Arweiniol Corfforaethol i'w hatgoffa mae dim ond un safle i bleidleisio sy'n cael ei ddefnyddio ar ddiwrnod etholiad.
- *As no acceptable response was received about election costs, Cllr Rhodri Evans was asked to contact Ms Lowri Edwards, Lead Corporation Officer, to remind her that only one location is used for voting in this community on election day.*
- Cyng Rhodri Evans ddim wedi dod i ben i ymchwilio ymhellach i mewn i'r contract gwreiddiol oddi wrth Jon Halle, Shareenergy, Small Wind Co-op. Cyng Rhodri Evans am ofyn i Jonathan Eirug edrych mewn i'r contract.
- *Cllr Rhodri Evans has not been able to make further progress in investigating the original contract from Jon Halle, Shareenergy, Small Wind Co-op. Cllr Rhodri Evans to ask Jonathan Eirug to look into the matter.*
- Ddim wedi'u wneud am y twll yn y ffordd ar y gornel sy'n troi lan am Bronaeron o Parchrhydderch eto.
- *Nothing has been done yet about the hole in the road on the corner up towards Bronaeron from Parchrhydderch.*
- Golau lamp stryd gyferbyn a Glynderwen ddim wedi'u hadnewyddu hyd yma, Cyng Rhodri Evans i siarad a Mr Simon Bray.
- *Streetlamp opposite Glynderwen has still not been replaced. Cllr Rhodri Evans to speak to Mr Simon Bray about it.*
- Twll wrth ymyl y ffordd rhwng Cnwc y Barcud a Cae Melyn ddim wedi derbyn sylw hyd yma. Cyng Rhodri Evans i siarad a'r Cyngor Sir.
- *Hole at the side of the road between Cnwc y Barcud and Cae Melyn still hasn't received any attention. Cllr Rhodri Evans to speak to County Council.*
- Dim ymateb wedi'u dderbyn, na chadarnhad derbyn y siec, o'r Treialon Cŵn Defaid Rhyngwladol hyd yma.
- *No response from International Sheepdog Trails that they have received the Community Council's cheque.*

- Gan nad oedd yna ddim ateb yn Edelweiss, Penuwch pan alwodd y Clerc ar ddau achlysur, gofynnir iddi ysgrifennu at y perchnogion.
- *As there was no one at home in Edelweiss, Penuwch, when the Clerk called on two occasions, she was asked to write to the owners of the property.*
- Trafodwyd ‘Ymgynghoriad ynghylch safleoedd posib ychwanegol – Cynllun Datblygu Lleol Ceredigion newydd (CDL12) 2018–2033 a fi’n dod i ben ar 12 Medi 2019 a chytunwyd gan nad oedd ardal Penuwch erioed wedi bod yn y cynllun bod angen ei ychwanegu nawr. Trafodwyd bod Penuwch ar y ffordd lle bod yna wasanaeth bysiau, tafarnau a nifer o fusnesau llewyrchus yn y gymuned. Soniwyd bod yna nifer iawn o’r bobl ifanc yr ardal am aros yn eu cymunedau oherwydd teuluoedd a busnesau’r teulu a bod angen i ni roi ein cefnogaeth i’w penderfyniadau. Gofynnir i Cyng Gwilym Evans ddod a’r wybodaeth o faint o dai sydd yn y gymuned i’r Clerc a’r cadeirydd ac i’r Cadeirydd ddrafftio llythyr i’w gymeradwyo gan Cyng Gwilym Evans a Cyng Emyr Jones ac i’r clerch drefnu ymateb i’r Cyngor erbyn y dyddiad cau.
- *The consultation with regard to extra possible sites – Ceredigion new Local Development Plan (CDL12) 2018–2033, which comes to an end on 12 September 2019, was discussed. It was agreed that, as Penuwch area had not been part of the plan in the past, it was now time that it was added. Penuwch now had a bus service, pubs and a number of successful businesses. Many local young people wanted to stay in the community because of family and business links and commitments, and their choices should be supported. Cllr Gwilym Evans was asked to ascertain how many dwellings there were in the Penuwch area and for the Chair to draft a letter, endorsed by Cllrs Gwilym Evans and Emyr Jones, reflecting this, and to be sent to the County Council by the closing date.*

Un Llais Cymru/One Voice Wales

Derbyniwyd gwybodaeth am gyfarfod cyffredinol blynyddol Un Llais Cymru a gynhelir ar ddydd Sadwrn 5ed o Hydref 2019 ym Mhafiliwn Pontrhydfendigaid. Cadeirydd i roi gwybod i'r Clerc os yw'n gallu mynychu.

Information was received about the One Voice Wales annual general meeting to be held on Saturday, 5 October 2019, at Pontrhydfendigaid Pavilion. The Chair was going to notify the Clerk if she was able to attend.

Unrhyw Fater Arall/Any Other Business

- Soniwyd nad oedd y poteli gwydr yn cael eu casglu o Llangeitho bellach.
- *It was noted that glass bottles were no longer being collected from Llangeitho.*
- Soniwyd bod gwasanaeth fan y swyddfa bost sy'n ymweld â'r pentref wedi eu cwtogi unwaith yn ragor a gan fod y gyrrwr yn derbyn llawdriniaeth yn yr Ysbyty, ni fu neb yn cynnal y gwasanaeth yn ei le. Cyng Daniel Thomas i ddod o hyd i gyfeiriad i ysgrifennu atynt trwy law'r clerch.
- *It was noted that the post office van service, which visits Llangeitho, had been suspended once again. The driver has had surgery and is in hospital, and no one has done the visits in his place. Cllr Daniel Thomas to look for an address so that the Council can write, noting its concern about the lack of service.*

- *It was noted that hedges needed to be cut back in Llwynpiod, as the undergrowth is collapsing after the recent bad weather. Cllr Rhodri Evans to discuss this with Phil Jones from the County Council.*
- Gwahoddir ceisiadau am gontractwyr i lanhau'r ffyrdd amser yr eira, ymgeiswyr a diddordeb i gysylltu'n uniongyrchol a swyddfa'r Cyngor Sir.
- *Applications from contractors to clean the roads after snowfall are invited. Those interested should contact the County Council directly.*
